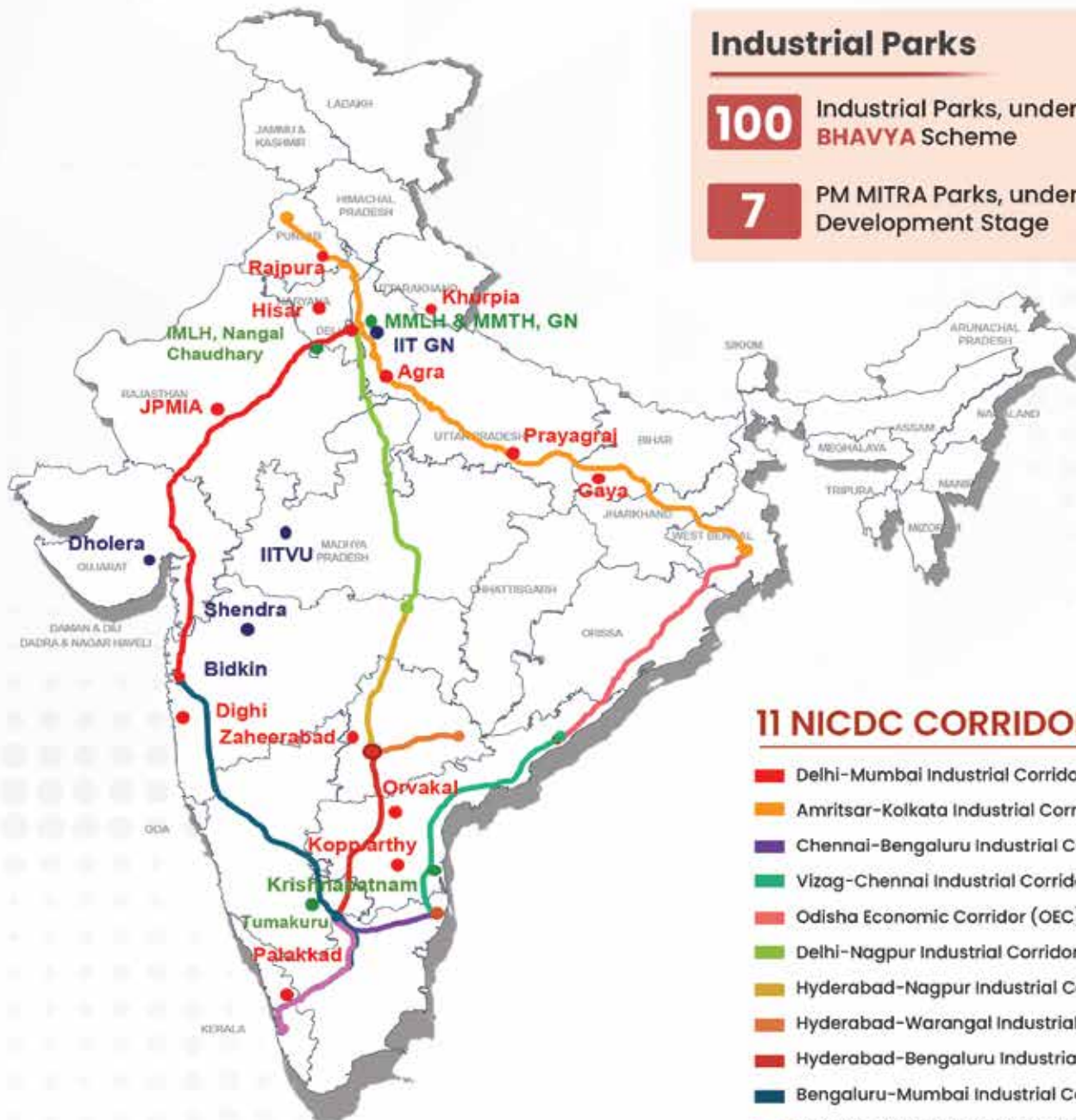

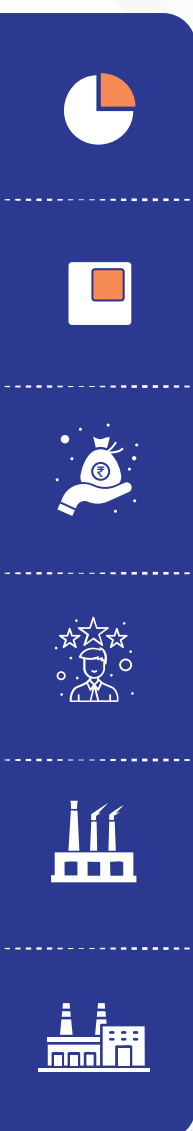

Foundation Stone Laid for Zaheerabad Industrial Area, Telangana | 10 May 2026

One of the defining milestones of the year, NICDC's Zaheerabad Industrial Area took a major step forward as Hon'ble Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi laid its foundation stone under the National Industrial Corridor Development Programme, alongside launching development projects worth over ₹9,400 crore in Hyderabad.

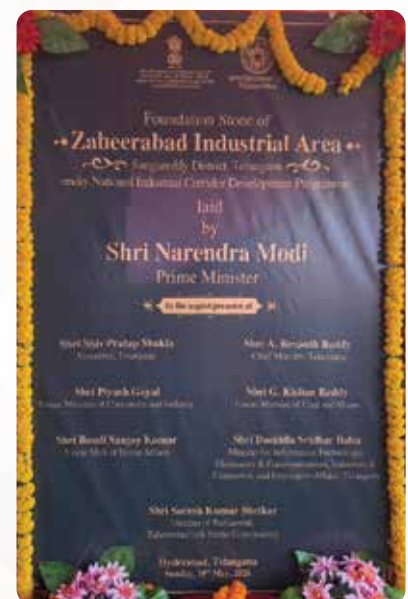

The project is expected to attract an investment potential of over ₹10,000 crore and generate nearly 1.74 lakh direct and indirect employment opportunities.

With a focus on sectors such as EVs, automobiles, electrical equipment, transport, metals, logistics, and food processing, Zaheerabad represents another significant step in NICDC's mission to create globally competitive industrial ecosystems and contribute to the vision of Viksit Bharat.

BHAVYA: The Next Big Thing in India's Industrial Parks Ecosystem

Following the landmark approval by the Union Cabinet, Hon'ble Minister Shri Ashwini Vaishnaw launched BHAVYA (Bharat Audyogik Vikas Yojana)—an ambitious programme to develop 100 investment-ready, plug-and-play industrial parks across the country.

With a project outlay of ₹33,660 crore, NICDC, as the implementing agency, is driving the programme to create world-class industrial ecosystems through integrated infrastructure, PM GatiShakti-aligned planning, and Ease of Doing Business reforms across the country.

Implementation is already underway, with the BHAVYA Portal now operational and the DPIIT implementation guidelines officially released, enabling States to move forward with the programme. Twenty industrial parks are expected to be taken up in the first phase, followed by another 30 parks in the subsequent phase.

NTH- AURIC Satellite Testing Laboratory and Sample Collection Centre inaugurated In Chhatrapati Sambhajinagar | 19 June 2026

A significant milestone in strengthening industrial infrastructure was the inauguration of the National Test House (NTH)–AURIC Satellite Testing Laboratory and Sample Collection Centre by Hon'ble Union Minister Shri Pralhad Joshi. Established in collaboration with NICDC, the Centre will serve industries in the Shendra–Bidkin Industrial Area and the wider Chhatrapati Sambhajinagar in marathwada region by providing testing, calibration, sample collection, and quality assurance services.

The facility is expected to reduce testing lead times, lower compliance costs, improve product quality, and enhance the competitiveness of manufacturing enterprises.

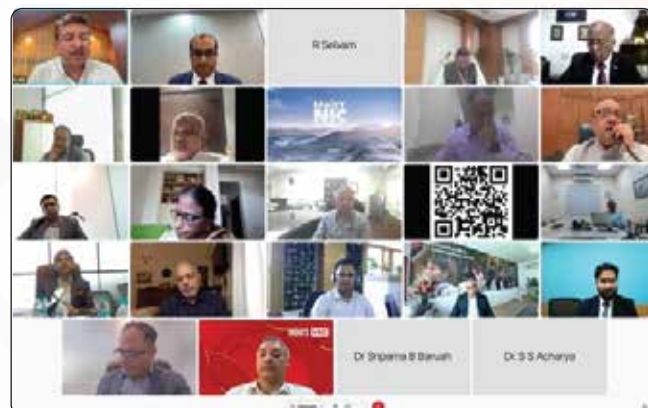


POST-BUDGET WEBINARS: FROM VISION TO ACTION

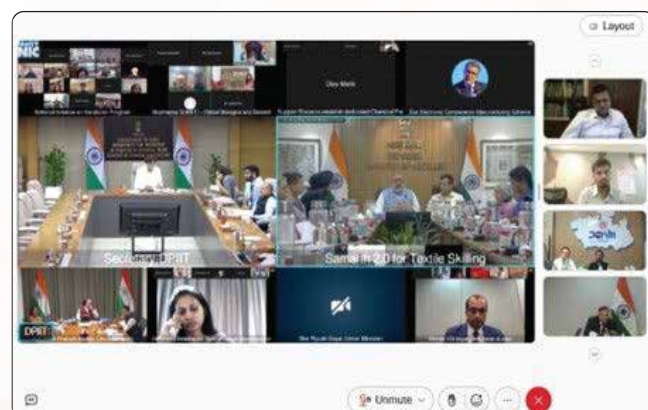


East Coast Industrial Corridor 3 March 2026
