New Industrial City Launched



Krishnapatnam Industrial Area (KRIS City) making Andhra Pradesh a model for new-age urbanization!

On January 8, 2025, Prime Minister Narendra Modi laid the foundation stone for the Krishnapatnam Industrial Area (KRIS City) in Tirupati District, Andhra Pradesh. As a greenfield industrial smart city under the Chennai-Bengaluru Industrial Corridor (CBIC), KRIS City is set to attract ₹10,500 crore in manufacturing investments and create around 100,000 jobs.

Andhra Pradesh is set to lead the way in modern urban development with the foundation stone for Krishnapatnam Industrial Area laid by Hon'ble PM Shri Narendra Modi.

This initiative is a major step in making Andhra Pradesh a leading hub for industrial and manufacturing excellence.

Incorporation of SPVs

Formation of BIMCGL Bihar Integrated Manufacturing City Gaya Limited - 6th January 2025



Establishment of Bihar Integrated Manufacturing City Gaya Ltd (BIMCGL), the Special Purpose Vehicle (SPV) driving the Integrated Manufacturing Cluster Gaya project. 29 agendas were approved at the first board meeting, paving the way for further development.

This milestone marks a significant step in developing Integrated Manufacturing Clusters in Agra and Prayagraj under the Amritsar-Kolkata Industrial Corridor (AKIC), boosting manufacturing growth and regional industrialization.

Both IMCs are designed to provide state-of-the-art infrastructure, Plug-n-Play facilities, and a business-friendly environment, ensuring rapid industrial development and economic expansion in Uttar Pradesh.

With such rapid progress, NICDC cities are proving to be the building blocks of India's journey towards becoming a global hub for manufacturing.

Formation of NICDIT Zaheerabad Industrial Smart City Limited – 7th February 2025



The NICDIT Zaheerabad Industrial Smart City Limited, a Special Purpose Vehicle (SPV), was incorporated on 07 February 2025 to spearhead the development of the Zaheerabad Industrial Area under the Hyderabad-Nagpur Industrial Corridor (HNIC). Designed to be a catalyst for industrial growth, the project will feature state-of-the-art 'plug-and-play' infrastructure at the plot level, complemented by world-class social

amenities. With seamless multi-modal connectivity to key export hubs, businesses will benefit from enhanced trade and logistics efficiency. A streamlined single-window clearance system will ensure fast-tracked approvals, making it easier for industries to set up operations. This industrial hub presents massive investment potential, expected to create thousands of jobs and drive economic transformation in Telangana.

INDIA is embarking on its most ambitious infrastructure programme yet – the National Industrial Corridor Development Programme (NICDP). Spearheaded by the National Industrial Corridor Development Corporation (NICDC), the initiative aims to position India as a global manufacturing and investment hub.

By developing 20 Greenfield Industrial Smart Cities, NICDC aims to create dynamic, investment-ready destinations for businesses to scale quickly and efficiently, and with reduced setup times, streamlined governance and smart, sustainable infrastructure.

These smart cities are not just industrial zones, but also designed to be hubs of innovation.

Accelerating business potential

With seamless connectivity, state-of-the-art infrastructure and pre-developed facilities, the smart cities cater to a wide variety of industries from manufacturing and electronics to biotechnology and semi-conductors.

Their key features include:

■ **Plug-and-play infrastructure:** These cities are equipped with state-of-the-art utilities, including 24/7 power supply, advanced water and wastewater treatment facilities and high-speed connectivity to help businesses commence operations from the get-go.


■ **Global connectivity:** The smart cities are strategically located along India's key industrial corridors.

They provide seamless access to major ports, airports, railways and highways, enabling businesses to transport goods efficiently to both domestic and global markets,

reducing costs and improving their time to market.

■ **Sustainable and smart design:** Sustainability and efficiency are prioritised through, for example, walk-to-work models, which integrate residential, commercial and industrial spaces.

Powered by renewable energy systems such as solar and wind energy, the cities reduce the carbon footprint of businesses, while ensuring energy reliability.

The success of the NICDP is already evident, with US\$20 billion in investments secured.

Global companies, such as

South Korea's Hyosung's operational textile mill, have established production facilities; Toyota-Kirloskar has an upcoming hybrid and electric vehicles plant.

Last year, the government of India approved 12 new NICDC Industrial Smart City projects worth US\$3.49 billion, spanning states such as Uttarakhand, Punjab, Maharashtra, Kerala, Uttar Pradesh, Bihar, Telangana, Andhra Pradesh and Rajasthan.

Specialty designed cities

These cities will be designed to reduce logistics costs, improve supply chain efficiencies as well as en-

hance India's attractiveness to international companies and investors. These projects open doors for Singaporean investors to access high-growth industrial hubs that are set to redefine global manufacturing and innovation.

Ahead of Prime Minister Narendra Modi's visit to Singapore last September, a government and business delegation from Singapore visited key NICDC hubs, including Dholera in Gujarat, Agra and Greater Noida in Uttar Pradesh, Shendra-Bidkin and Dighi in Maharashtra, Tumakuru in Karnataka, Krishnapatnam in Andhra Pradesh and Neemrana in Rajasthan.

Business leaders from Singapore acknowledged the immense opportunities for collaboration, thanks to the investment-ready infrastructure and growth potential of these hubs.

Enterprise Singapore is actively collaborating with NICDC to strengthen bilateral ties and unlock new opportunities for Singapore investors.

India's massive market potential, with a population of over 1.4 billion, further enhances the appeal of these hubs.

Complemented by reforms such as Production-Linked Incentive (PLI) schemes, reduced compli-

ance burdens and attractive tax incentives, the NICDP makes it easier for foreign investors to establish and scale operations.

The pursuit of foreign investment led the NICDC team to hold roadshows in Dubai and Abu Dhabi.


