Request for Proposal (RFP) is invited in two cover system by the Managing Director, Kerala Industrial Corridor Development Corporation Limited (KICDC) Ernakulam, Selection of Consultant for feasibility study for setting up a Wind and Solar Energy power projects at Integrated Manufacturing Clusters , Pudusserry-Palakkad under Kochi Bengaluru Industrial Corridor (KBIC) Project.

1. The Kerala Industrial Corridor Development Corporation Limited

1.1. Introduction/Background

Kerala Industrial Corridor Development Corporation Limited (KICDC) is special purpose vehicle formed for the implementation of Kochi Bangalore Industrial Corridor (KBIC). KICDC is 50:50 joint venture between Govt of India (NICDIT) and Govt of Kerala(KINFRA) . The land acquisition of the KBIC is in progress at two nodes at Palakkad and Kochi. In Palakkad three land parcel has been identified which is approximately 1700acres for the development of integrated manufacturing cluster (IMC) - Puthussery central, Puthusseri West and Kannambra. The acquisition of the land is in final stage and the master planning is also in progress.

1.2. KINFRA: Kerala Industrial Infrastructure Development Corporation

Kerala Industrial Infrastructure Development Corporation, KINFRA aims at bringing together all the suitable resources available in the state and developing infrastructure to woo the industrial growth of the state. KINFRA is dedicated to catalyzing industrial growth in Kerala by providing the best industry-specific infrastructure.

KINFRA has identified over 20 key competency areas. It has 24 well - defined industrial parks of which many are functional and some are in launching phase. Each of these Parks offers a comprehensive infrastructure and support service to the clients.

The head office of KINFRA is located at Thiruvananthapuram, the state capital of Kerala. The parks of KINFRA are scattered in different parts of the state. In working towards its goal of metamorphosing Kerala in to an industrialized state, KINFRA takes utmost care to protect the natural environs as the state is one of the greenest in the country

1.3. NICDIT: National Industrial corridor Development and Implementation Trust:

Delhi Mumbai Industrial Corridor Development Corporation (DMICDC) Limited was incorporated on 7th January 2008 as a Special Purpose Vehicle (SPV) under the Administrative Control of DPIIT, Ministry of Commerce & Industry, for carrying out project development activities and coordinating the implementation of the various projects.

After expansion of the DMIC Trust's mandate and reconstitution of the same as National Industrial Corridor Development and Implementation Trust (NICDIT) in December 2016, DMICDC Ltd. was renamed to National Industrial Corridor Development Corporation (NICDC) Limited in February 2020, for developing various Industrial Corridor Projects as part of India's flagship 'National Industrial Corridor Program'.

NICDC is mandated to undertake project development activities for investment regions / industrial areas / economic regions / industrial nodes and townships / integrated manufacturing clusters / stand-alone projects / early bird projects for various industrial corridor projects and also assist various State Governments.

NICDC undertakes various project development activities like preparation of master plans, feasibility reports, detailed project reports etc. and acts as an intermediary for the purpose of

development and establishment of infrastructure projects through developing and disseminating appropriate financial instruments, negotiating loans and advances of all nature, and formulating schemes for mobilization of resources and extension of credit for infrastructure.

2. Selection of Consultant:

2.1. Objective:

Renewable energy development has become ever more significant in the present-day context, for its potential to decelerate the impact of climate change, to augment energy availability, to conserve conventional energy and control the individual energy expenses. Utilizing the freely available abundant renewable energy sources like the solar energy, wind energy and so on is indispensable for Kerala, a State that has to import more than half of the total electricity demand. However, this requires coordinated efforts to ensure wider participation of people as well as planners and developers.

In this context KICDC envisages to roll out focused programmes for harnessing untapped renewable energy resources available at the industrial areas. A 16 MW wind farm established at the Kanjikkode KIFRA park is a best example of this endeavor. KICDC is in the process of identifying all the available renewable energy resources in the part of the Integrated Manufacturing Cluster (IMC) at the Palakkad node in Kerala.

3. Scope of work by the Consultant:

3.1. Wind:

- Study of wind flow / velocity, etc. by erecting wind mast, if required
- Submit a preliminary report on the study
- Identifying suitable locations / micro siting for wind turbines in the project area. Auto Cad sketch of the land parcels will be shared by KICDC .
- Finalizing the area required for the wind farms.
- Finalizing the total capacity of wind power generation.
- Setting out of the points and google coordinates in accordance with the draft master plan & its internal roads in association with M/s. Jacobs CH2M, the consultant of the Project.
- Optimum utilization of land linking with the master plan facilities.
- Finalizing the power evacuation mode as per master plan.
- Submission of final Feasibility Report.

3.2. Solar:

- Conducting the study to utilize the un-allotable land in the project area. Auto Cad sketch of the land parcels will be shared by KICDC.
- Conduct study to use the govt. lands, rocks etc. for the project.
- Finalizing the area required for the solar project.
- Finalizing the total capacity of solar power generation.
- Optimum utilization of land in linking with the master plan facilities.
- Finalizing the power evacuation master plan.
- Submission of final Feasibility Report

3.3. General:

- Assisting / coordinating with M/s Jacob's project management consultant for incorporating the locations identified for the above projects in the master plan.
- Submission of preliminary drawings, etc.
- Incorporating corrections /suggestions made by the client.
- Finalizing the lay out plan.

- Submitting a feasibility report with lay out drawing including the locations proposed, coordinates for micro siting the locations, etc.
- Suggesting marketing methodology and probable investor
- Preparation of detailed layout drawings, Submission to client for approval, Modification if any, to be incorporated in the drawings and resubmitted for approval.

4. Eligibility criteria:

- 4.1. The applicant must be a reputed & registered, experienced consulting firm having experience in the field of consultancy for setting up of wind & solar power generation plants.
- 4.2. The applicant should have completed the work as consultant and/or project management consultant in setting up of a wind power plant with capacity of minimum capacity of 10 MW and a solar power of minimum 5MW. The applicant should have completed the work of consultancy for setting up of wind / solar power plant within last seven (7) years (ending the last date of month previous to the one in which the applications are invited for selection). Firm should have completed works in the capacity of consultant or a similar role exclusively for wind / solar power generation. The applicant has to submit work order showing the works awarded to the applicant by their clients, its duration, completion certificate, etc. as proof for the above.
- 4.3. The firm should have GST registration certificate.
- 4.4. Joint Venture or Consortium constituted for participating in this tender alone is not permitted.
- 4.5. The Participant shall be required to submit self-attested copies of the following documents along with the RFP in Cover I
 - i. Copy of registration certificate of the firm.
 - ii. Documents supporting the claim as per the above including the appointment letter / work order or contract agreement Along with completion certificate.
 - iii. Details of Permanent Account Number (PAN).
 - iv. GST registration certificate.
 - v. Processing Fee as Demand Draft payable at Managing Director-KINFRA, Trivandrum

- 4.6. The Participant shall be required to submit following documents along with the RFP in Cover II:

5. Instructions & Guidelines for Submission of Application for Selection of Consultant:

- 5.1 The document can be downloaded from our website at www.kinfra.org
- 5.2 Any addendum/corrigendum relating to this RFP will be published in KINFRA website only & these will be form part of the tender. Bidders are requested to visit KINFRA site frequently.
- 5.3 The applicant must submit a non-refundable **processing fee (Tender fee) of Rs.5,900/-** (Rupees Five Thousand Nine Hundredonly) (including GST 18%) in the form of DD drawn in favour of MD KINFRA, payable at Trivandrum. Proposal submitted without processing will be summarily rejected.
- 5.4 The application shall be signed by the authorized person(s) of the firm. All pages of the RFP document shall be signed, and seal affixed by the applicant.
- 5.5 The application shall be submitted only as per the enclosed format(s) along with Annexures, Self-attested documentary proof(s) in respect of the details furnished in the application form.

The intending firms shall also submit the list of such projects where due to any disputes litigation was invoked and or the consultancy services were abandoned/suspended by the client(s).

Suppression of any information in this regard may lead to disqualification of the Firm concerned, if such information comes to the notice of KICDC, subsequently incomplete applications will be summarily rejected.

- 5.6 KICDC reserves the right to accept or reject any application or cancel this RFP process without

- 5.7 Summary of regular/permanent professional employees and key personnel including the nature of specialization, qualifications and experience should be enclosed along with certificates.
- 5.8 Applicants should give an undertaking certifying that the firm has not been blacklisted by any Govt./Local bodies/PSUs or any other organizations / institution in the country.
- 5.9 Applicants who have successfully fulfilled minimum criteria shall be eligible to apply. Certified copies of award letters, work order, contract agreement, completion certificate from the client should be enclosed.
- 5.10 Application with annexures I to V along with documentary proofs and details of supporting documents required in the above clauses shall be submitted in sealed envelope super scribing "**Cover I - Technical Bid for Selection of Consultant for feasibility study for setting up a Wind and Solar Energy power projects at Integrated Manufacturing Clusters , Pudusserry-Palakkad**". - 5.12 RFP submitted by firms formed as joint ventures for the purpose of participating in this particular RFP is not eligible.
- 5.13 KICDC shall not be responsible for any delay/ loss of documents or incorrect filling of application form and annexures I to V of the application. Also, KICDC shall not be responsible for delay/ non-receipt of filled-in application form along with documentary proofs sent by registered post.
- 5.14 KICDC reserves the right to modify the criteria and take its own decision if so required.
- 5.15 The evaluation of the applications submitted by the firms shall be undertaken based on details submitted by them strictly as per requirement of this RFP document. 6. Evaluation Criteria:

6.1. Following points are considered for evaluation:

- i. Organizational Details.
- ii. Experience of Consultancy assignments completed as per 4.1 or any other relevant clause of this RFP.
- iii. Consultancy assignments in progress.

6.2. The marks shall be decided by a duly constituted Committee on the basis of predetermined criteria and where it is not possible to do so, based on their own judgment. The evaluation carried out by the said Committee shall be final and binding.

6.3. KICDC reserves the right to modify the criteria and take own decision if so required.

7. Evaluation of proposals and process of selection

7.1. General:

The proposals shall be evaluated on the basis of CQCCBS (Combined Quality cum-Cost Based Selection) for which maximum 70 marks for technical proposal have been assigned and maximum 0 marks for financial proposal have been assigned. The price bids of those who meet Eligibility criteria as per clause no 4 of tender document, only will be opened. The Consultant who scores highest marks on addition of technical evaluation and price evaluation marks shall be declared the successful consultant.

7.2. Technical Evaluation:

The technical bid will carry maximum marks of 70, The Evaluation Committee nominated by KICDC shall validate the bids on the basis of eligibility and qualification requirement as given above. Indicative marks to each criterion are pre-assigned with in proportion to its relevance to the expected grade and nature of services and will be shown against each point in each section. The response of the bidders will be evaluated as per the following criteria.

The bidders who have completed works in Govt. Sector	10 Marks

7.3. Financial Evaluation:

Financial bids of those who meet Eligibility criteria only will be opened.

- i. Lowest of the Price Bids will carry 30 marks and higher priced bids will be given pro-rata scores. (i.e. for L2, Percentages of $L1/L2 \times 100$ will be the Price Bid

score.

- ii. A composite score (weighted average) of technical and financial scores will be worked for each bidder. While calculating the composite score, the weightage shall be 70% for technical score and 30% for financial score.
- iii. The selection of the Consultant shall be based on the highest of the Composite Score.
- iv. KICDC reserves the right to reject any/ or all of the bids in part/ or in full without assigning any reason.

8. Successful bidder:

- 8.1. The successful bidder shall be selected based on the evaluation of Technical bid and scoring of the bid.
- 8.2. The subject work will be awarded to the successful bidder and the bidder would be required to sign the agreement with KICDC within 15 days from the date of work order along with security deposit (5% of quoted amount) by way of DD in favour of Managing Director, KINFRA payable at Trivandrum.
